Crash Course: Redistricting in Nebraska 2020

This is an overview of redistricting in Nebraska which is appropriate for civic groups, high school and college students. It was developed by the League of Women Voters of Nebraska as part of the Fair Maps Nebraska campaign. It runs about 40-50 minutes, depending on class discussion and questions.

Following the presentation, participants should be familiar with the following:

- 1. Redistricting terms and vocabulary;
- 2. Elective offices in Nebraska subject to redistricting;
- 3. Nebraska's current redistricting process and ways that it might be improved;
- 4. Problems cited in Nebraska's 2011 redistricting; and
- 5. Redistricting in other states.
